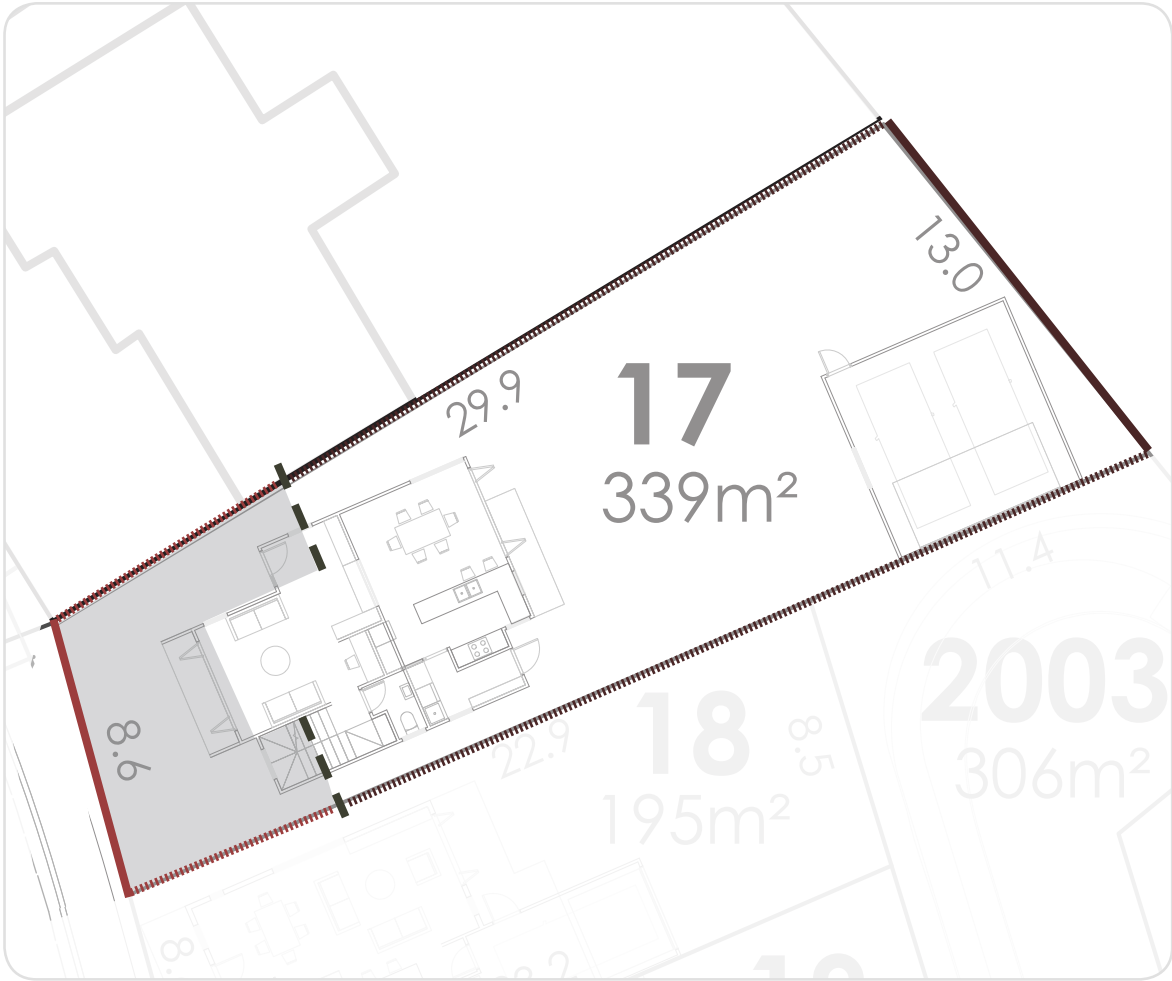


Figure A Spatial Representation of a Typical Front Lot

Introduction

This document contains landscape guidelines for planting and fencing residential lots in both the Meadowlands Precinct Stage (lots 1-13, block 1) and Stage 1A (lots 17-34, blocks 3 and 4) of Halswell Commons.

A front lot includes the area between the front boundary and the front facing walls of the building (as indicated in Figure A).

Under the landscape guidelines the property frontage areas are divided into 'front landscape zone,' 'side landscape zone,' and 'general landscape zone.' Tree species are included where appropriate.

Fencing guidelines are included for residential lots in the Meadowlands Precinct/Stage 1A zone and are divided into 'front boundary,' 'side front boundary,' 'back boundary' and 'side rear boundary.'

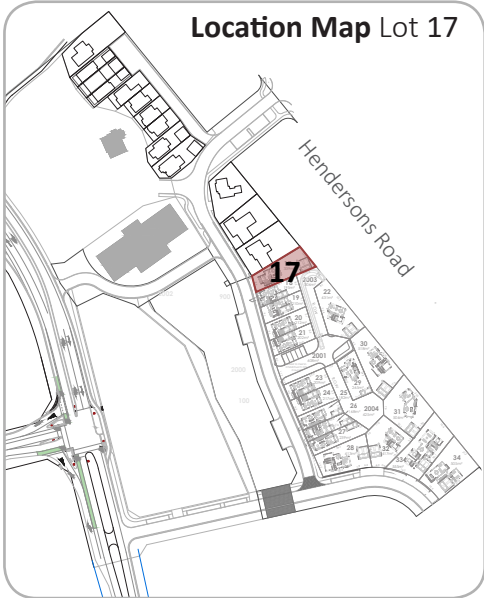
GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- Landscaping will become an extension of the streetscape; enhancing street amenity and softening the built form
- Landscaping is intended to enable passive surveillance through maintaining visual permeability from house to street
- Landscaping is intended to encourage neighbourhood interaction and engagement with the street by serving as a visually shared public/private interface
- Houses shall provide direct and clear access to the street for pedestrians

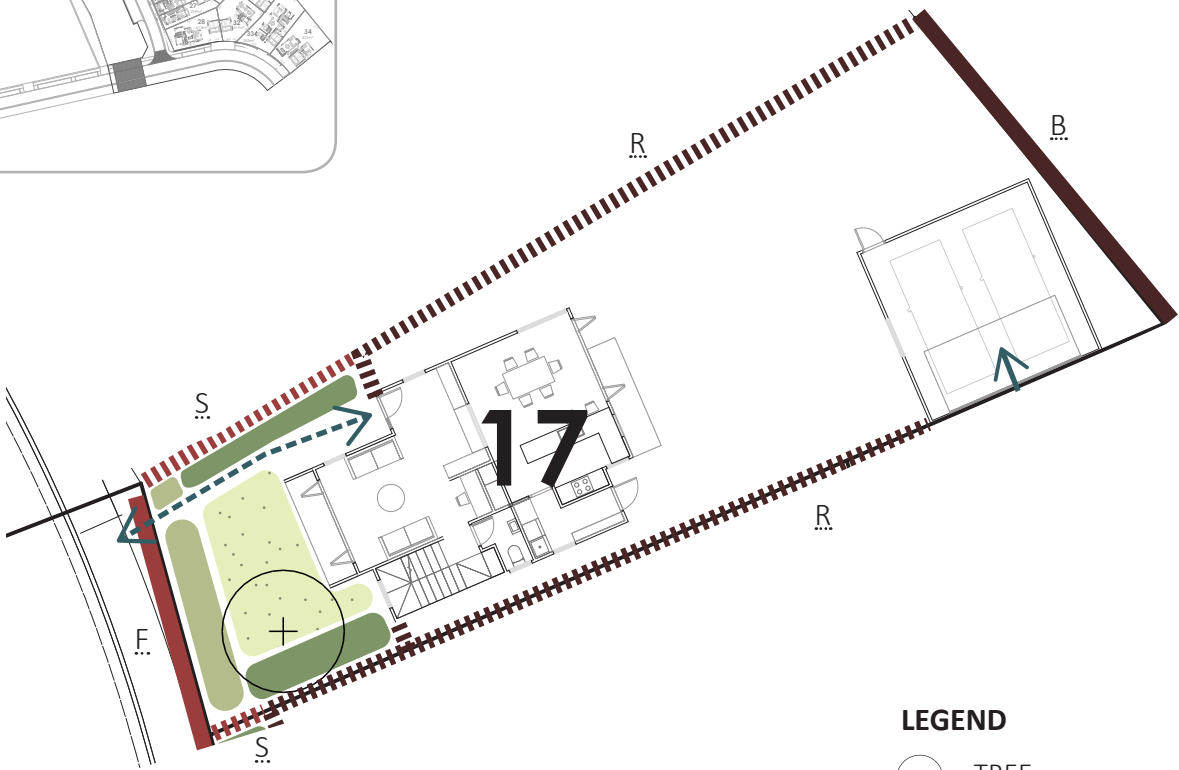

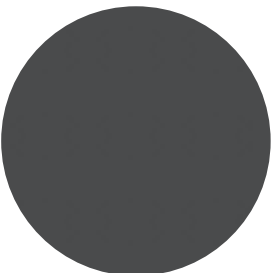

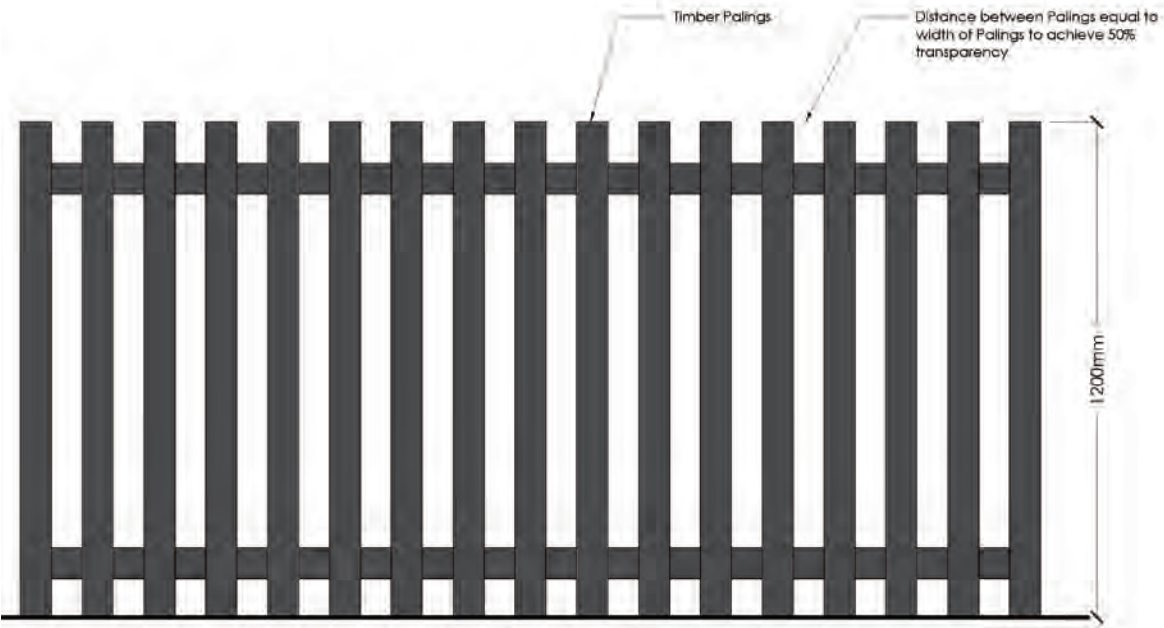

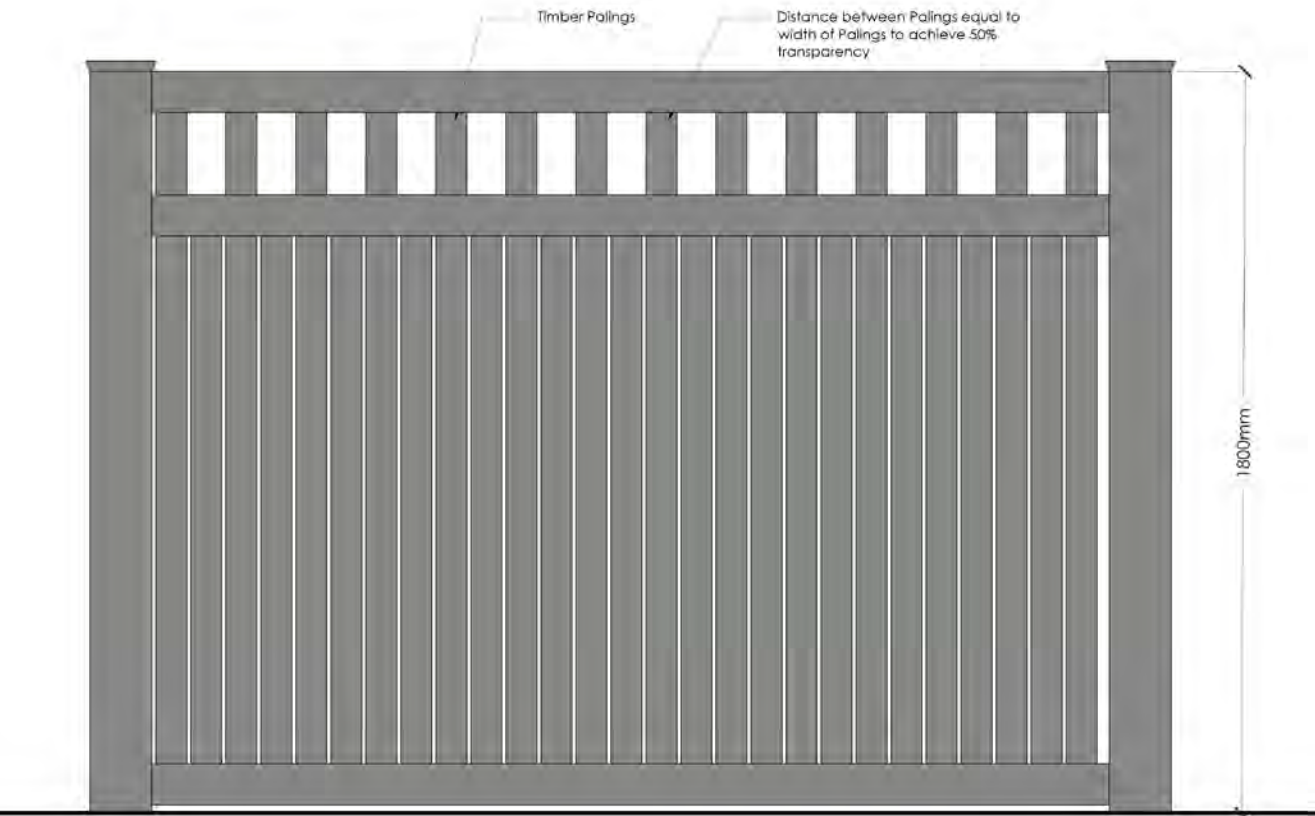


TYPE 2. TIMBER WITH TRELLIS

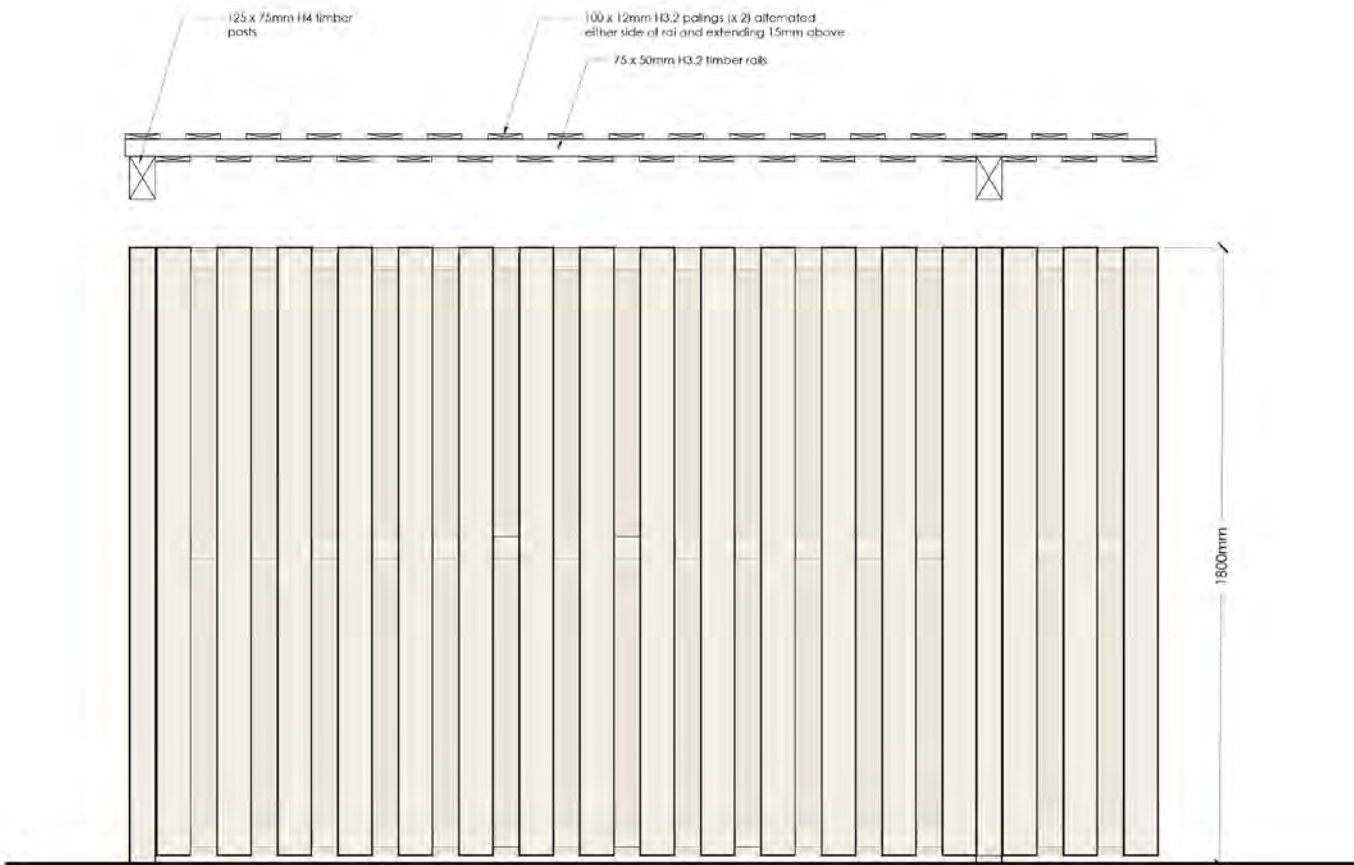
